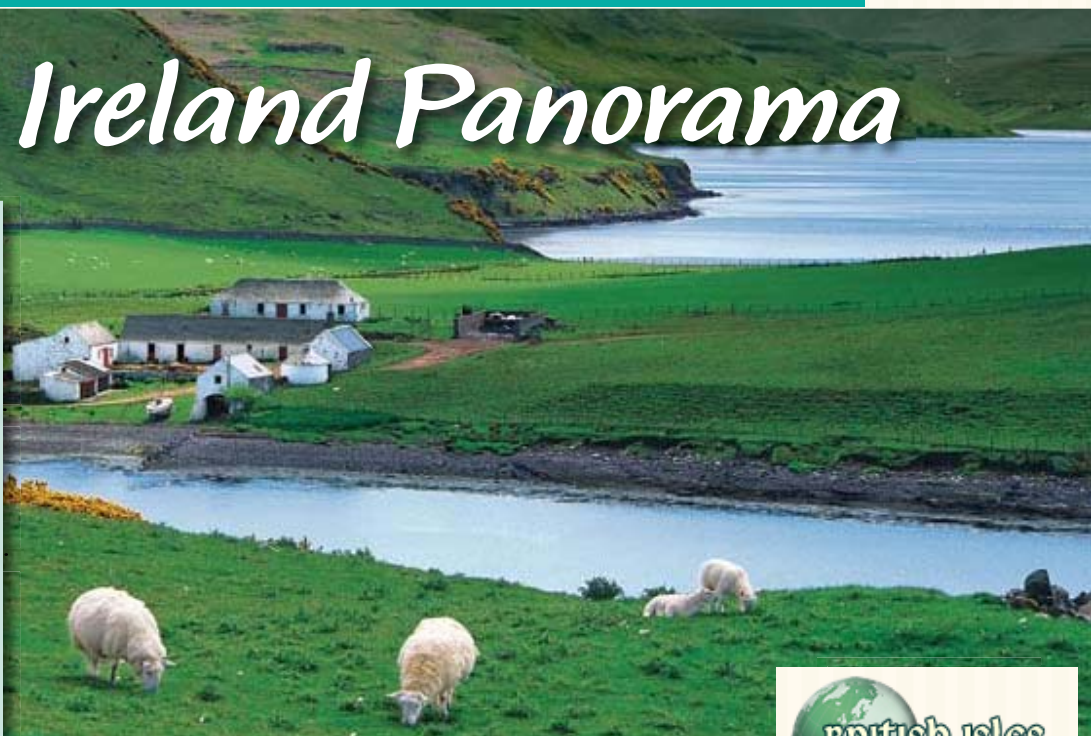

DAY 1

Depart USA*

Board your overnight transatlantic flight.

DAY 2

Arrive in London, England

Welcome to London! After checking into the hotel, the time is at leisure.

DAY 3

London / Stratford / Coventry / York

Drive through the scenic Cotswolds to Stratford-upon-Avon. Visit Shakespeare's birthplace and see Anne Hathaway's thatched cottage. Then to Coventry, and on to York. Take a walking tour along the narrow cobbled streets. Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Drink and dinner with our Tour Director and fellow travelers. (CB,D)

DAY 4

York / Northumberland / Edinburgh, Scotland

This morning, drive through Northumberland National Park. Stop at a section of Hadrian's Wall and see the ruins of Jedburgh Abbey before reaching Edinburgh, the Scottish capital. (FB)

DAY 5

Edinburgh Sightseeing and at Leisure

Our morning sightseeing tour with a local guide includes the elegant New Town, Princes Street, the Royal Mile, views of Holyrood House and Arthur's Seat and a guided visit of the apartments inside Edinburgh Castle. During the Festival, we include tickets to the spectacular Edinburgh Tattoo. (FB)




DAY 6**Edinburgh / St. Andrews / Scottish Highlands**

Drive to St. Andrews and its celebrated golf course. Stop at the 18th hole before crossing through the heart of the Scottish highlands to Laggan. (FB,D)

DAY 7**Scottish Highlands / Loch Ness / Isle of Skye**

First to the famous battle site of Culloden and then to Scotland's most famous lake, Loch Ness. On to the Kyle of Lochalsh where we cross the sea to Skye! This afternoon there is an opportunity to see the spectacular scenery of the Trotternish Peninsula. (FB,D)

DAY 8**Isle of Skye / Loch Lomond / Glasgow**

First to Fort William to see the "Vale of Weeping" at Glencoe. Then onto Glasgow. An orientation tour includes George Square, the cathedral, the River Clyde and a hidden treasure . This evening, we enjoy Scottish hospitality at our Highlight Dinner. (FB,HD)

DAY 9**Glasgow / Lake District, England / Liverpool**

South to the border and Gretna Green. Then through the English Lake District to Grasmere and Lake Windermere. In Chester, a walking tour will include the galleried "Rows." Continue to Liverpool. (FB,D)

DAY 10**Liverpool / Dublin, Ireland**

Drive along the North Wales coast to the Island of Anglesey stopping at the Welsh railway station with the longest name in the world, Llanfairpwllgwyngyllgogerychwyrndrobwillantysiliogogogoch. Then to Holyhead for our ferry to Dublin. (FB)

DAY 11**Dublin Sightseeing and at Leisure**


A sightseeing tour comprises a visit to Trinity College to see the beautiful Book of Kells, and views of St. Patrick's Cathedral and Phoenix Park. The rest of the day is at leisure. (FB)

DAY 12**Dublin / Galway / Limerick**

Travel to the West coast and on to Limerick. (FB)

DAY 13**Limerick / Ring of Kerry / Killarney Area**

Today we experience Ireland's most scenic coastal drive, the Ring of Kerry. The varied landscape is a photographer's delight. (FB)

DAY 14**Killarney Area / Waterford **

Travel to Blarney Castle where we have the chance to kiss the famous stone. Then to Waterford to visit the Waterford Crystal Showrooms. (FB,D)

DAY 15**Waterford / Cardiff, Wales**

Drive to Rosslare to board the ferry across the Irish Sea. Arrive in Pembroke and head to Cardiff. (FB)

DAY 16**Cardiff / Bath, England / Plymouth **

Drive to historic Bath. Visit to Roman Baths, then on to King Arthur's Glastonbury.

Stop for a delicious cream tea before continuing to Plymouth. (FB)









